Copyright information

With an increasing number of churches including video clips in services, or starting film clubs, the following restrictions should be noted:

- YouTube clips cannot be shown without the copyright holders' permission – blanket permission for church use is given by Hillsong and the Bible Society;
- Commercial films – the name of the film cannot be advertised on posters outside of church or on social media or on church websites. The film can be named on posters within church (if not visible from outside) and on flyers handed out to individuals.
